Saturday, October 10 Night Kite Fly
Sunday, October 11, 10 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Event

We have been watching the weather quite closely for the past 10 days and have been in direct communication with NOAA meteorologists in Boulder regarding the forecasts for Saturday night and daytime, Sunday. The decision as to whether to proceed with the Saturday evening and Sunday One Sky One World events is being based on predicted temperatures and the likelihood of precipitation.

In an updated forecast at 11:30 a.m. today, the weather conditions for Saturday night are predicted to be very cold and snowy. Therefore, Saturday Night Kite Fly activities are being canceled.

Weather on Sunday is forecast to be snow in the morning, chance of snow in the afternoon with temperatures between 39 and 44 degrees. Its advisable, therefore to cancel the live musical entertainment and speeches on the Performance Stage and the Colorado Disc Dogs, and the Children and Pet Parade for Peace.

The wind, however, will be perfect for kiteflying, from the southeast at 10 to 15 MPH. An attempt will therefore be made to do a Giant Kite Battle. International Kite Artists, Melanie Walker, George Peters (Boulder) and Anka and Kisa Sauer (Germany) will be present as well as a number of local kite enthusiasts.

Food, beverages, beer and wine will be available in the heated Pavilion Building. Through, the Internet program Skype, we will be connecting through the cyber-sky to other One Sky One World Kite Fly locations (you will be able to see weather and kiteflying elsewhere!). People attending the event will receive bags with give-away items and coupons and are still welcome to fly kites.

Vendors and exhibitors are welcome to come and set up at their own discretion. Anyone who has paid booth registration fees will be given a credit toward next year's event. Next year's One Sky One World is being planned as a two-day event on September 18 & 19 to coincide with the United Nations Day of Peace and the Autumnal Equinox.
